


ACROSS

- 1. Tool used to apply paint to a surface.

- 5. Paint that is used with LOTS of water and has a thin quality.

- 1. Material that is used as a kind of glue to hold clay together.
- 2. Long tubes of clay that can be used to make hand-built pottery or decorations.
- 3. The stage that you want clay to be at before it goes into a kiln.
- 4. This is what you do to remove air bubbles from the clay.
- 5. Flat pieces of clay that are assembled like a building.
- 6.This is a small hole or holes that are poked into a clay piece to release air and avoid explosion in the kiln.
- 7. Pottery made of clay fired to a porous state which can be made impervious to liquids by the use of a glaze.
- 8. Fired clay that is not glazed and is no longer workable.
- 9. Machine that helps to thrown pottery such as bowls, plates, and vessels.

- 2. The stage of clay where it isn't completely dry, and can still be manipulated and carved into.
- 3. This tool is used to smooth clay. It can be made of wood, plastic, or metal.

- 5. Coating which has been fused to a ceramic body through firing.
